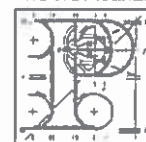

Please be advised that EirGrid intends to apply to An Bord Pleanála for permission/approval for the proposed development of the West Dublin 220/110 kV Substation and Associated Works project, to be located in South County Dublin.

The West Dublin 220/110 kV Substation and Associated Works project consists of the following principal elements:

- A 220/110 kV Gas Insulated Switchgear (GIS) Substation (approximately three hectare (ha) site) situated in the townlands of Ballybane and Aungierstown and Ballybane;
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- An access route to the eastern interface compound (approximately 240 m in length) connecting to Lynches Lane (L-5218-1);
- An access route to the western interface compound (approximately 1.3 km) connecting to the R120 regional road via an existing access road currently serving the Lucan Sarsfields GAA Club sports grounds;
- Four 220 kV underground cables connecting the two interface compound sites with the new substation;
- One 110 kV underground cable connecting the existing 110 kV Corkagh substation to the proposed substation; and
